

Compared to these other options, Trilogy is lighter and has superior optics. It also has better impact resistance than most high index materials. For most prescriptions—the approximately 92% for mild to moderately strong near or far sightedness— Trilogy is as thin, or thinner than, the other "thin and light" materials.

For really strong prescriptions, talk with your eye care professional about which lenses will be your best option. The clear, crisp vision and lighter weight advantages Trilogy offers are especially dramatic in strong prescriptions, but occasionally there may be tradeoffs between weight and thinness.

These comparisons are based on the same center thickness (1.5mm) and edge thickness (2mm) and a 50mm found diameter lens.
